design Kengo Kuma

Swedish furniture craftsmanship meets Japanese global architecture in the *HidaHida* chair. In Japanese, 'hida' means to drape. Here we see the chair's fabric swept over the frame in an embracing gesture. The designer is the world-famous architect Kengo Kuma who finds inspiration in craftsmanship and local building traditions. The craftsmanship of Gärsnäs awakened his interest and led to the collaboration. *HidaHida* has a precise frame and soft backrest of recycled felt covered in fabric or leather. At the back, the material hangs free, like a skirt. *HidaHida* is available in beech or oak.



# JUDITH

*Judith*: coat hanger, hat stand and shoe rack. Functional and beautiful simplicity in wood. *Judith* can be expanded lengthwise to suit large hallways and company entrances. Milled grooves on the upper side provide stability for the hangers and add tactile presence. Made of laminated oak.
